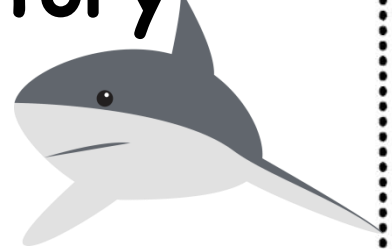

# Oceans - Whales

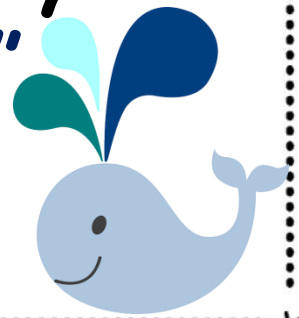

Can you look all through your house and collect toys that start with the letter "O"

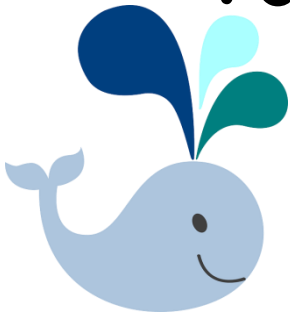
## Project-Bubble Art

Did you know many different kinds of fish live in the ocean?

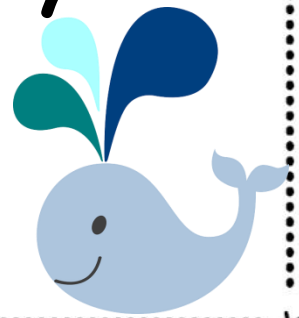
